

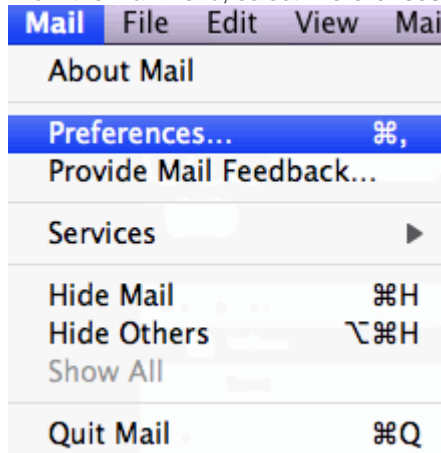
# Setting Up Your Apple Mail

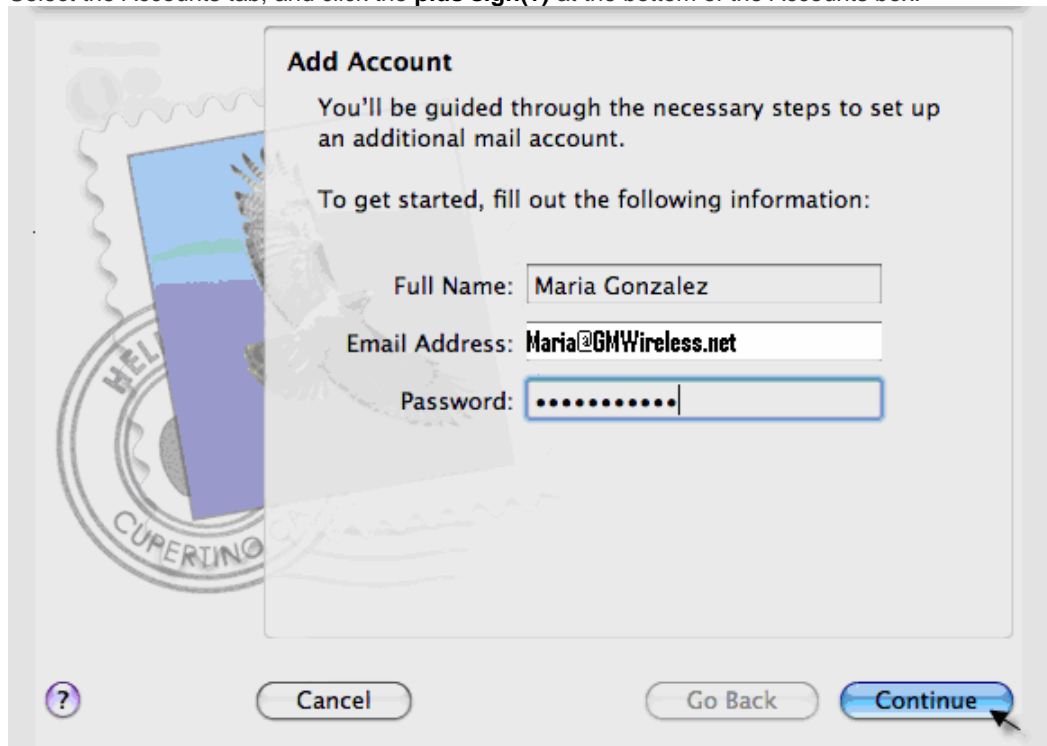
This tutorial shows you how to set up Apple Mail to work with your email account.

## To Set Up Your Apple Mail

1. From the Mail menu, select **Preferences**.



2. Select the Accounts tab, and click the **plus sign(+)** at the bottom of the Accounts box.



3. In the Add Account window, enter your full name, email address and email password. Click **Continue**.

4. In the Incoming Mail Server screen, select **POP** from the **Account Type** list, and enter your information as follows:

**Description**

Enter the name of your account.

**Incoming mail server (POP3)**

Type **pop.GMWireless.net**.


**User Name**

Enter your email address.

**Password**

Enter the password you set up for your email account.

Click **Continue**.

5. In the Outgoing Mail Server screen enter your information as follows:

**Description**

Enter the name for this mail server (e.g. secureserver.net).


**Outgoing mail server**

Mail.GMWireless.nett and check the **Use only this server** box.

**Use Authentication**

Check the Use Authentication box and type your User Name and Email Address.

Click **Continue**.
